Kiwanis Club of Santee Fishing Derby Rules

- 1. The Fishing Derby is for students in grades 3rd through 8th.
- 2. All participants will be required to check in upon arrival to the derby.
- 3. Contestants may supply their own bait; however, free bait will be available near the registration table.
- 4. Contest hours are from 7:00 to 11:00 am (4 hours of fishing).
- 5. Any fish caught before the starting time will not count as part of the Derby.
- 6. The Derby will begin and end on time.
- 7. All contestants must fish from the shoreline or piers.
- 8. Only 1 fishing line per participant will be allowed to be qualified for prizes in the Derby.
- 9. All Fish must be caught by the contestant's fishing pole. Once measured, a fin will be taken from the fish. If the contestant wishes to release the back into the lake it must be done in view of the judging area.
- 10. The assistance of young contestants by parents or adults is endorsed; however, parents cannot fish for their children and children must be actively involved in the catching of all fish.
- 11. Fish caught during the Derby will be measured and entered on a data sheet by the Fishing Derby judges. Derby fish are tallied up and looked over for a chance to win one of the 4 prizes.
- 12. All decisions by judges are final. Any arguments or disagreements will be immediate grounds for disqualification.
- 13. Contestants can only place within one of 4 categories (1 prize per contestant).
 - Biggest fish (3rd-6th)
 - Most fish caught (3rd-6th)
 - Biggest fish (7th-8th)
 - Most fish caught (7th-8th)
- 14. Award winners must be present at the awards ceremony at 11:00 am near the registration table to receive their prize.
